CHAR YONG (DABU) NATIONAL YOUTH TOP 10
TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT RANKING POINT/POLICY

A. Introduction

The purpose of this policy is to govern and determine the top 10 players with the highest ranking points in each age group category for the Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012.

B. Category for Ranking Point Consideration

C. Points Table

Kindly refer to attached National Ranking Policy for the points table. Players will be ranked in their respective tiers.

1. To qualify for Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012, all players have to attend **at least 2 of the local tournaments** as listed under section B - Category for Ranking Point Consideration.
2. Allocation of the points is based on the following eligibility criterias:
 - 2.1 Points will be awarded to players who participate in the Singles Events only.
 - 2.2 Points can be awarded to a same player who participate in 2 age group events respectively (subject to the Rules & Regulations of each individual tournament). He/she can qualify up to a maximum of 2 events in Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012, restricted to the next highest age group only. (Example: U12 player can qualify for U12 and U15, U15 player can qualify for U15 and U18).
 - 2.3 The top 10 players with the highest ranking point will qualify for the Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012. In the event that there is a tie in the 10th position, it will be determined by an open draw.(Example: There are 4 tie positions in the 7th positions with the same ranking points, they will be draw into positions 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th positions.)
3. Replacement of Player:
 - 3.1 **Before the official draw** – should there be any withdrawal of the top 10 ranking players before the official draw, the subsequent ranked player will qualify for the Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012
 - 3.2 **After the official draw** – should there be any withdrawal of the top 10 ranking players after the official draw, there will be no replacement to fill up the Char Yong (DABU) National Youth Top 10 Table Tennis Tournament 2012.

D. Validity

The points are valid for 1 calendar year only. They cannot be carried forward to the following year.

E. Reservation of Rights

In the event of any ambiguity not clearly addressed by the above policy, STTA management reserves the right to make the final decision.
