NEW COACH FOR SINGAPORE MEN'S TABLE TENNIS TEAM

Yang Chuan Ning, 51 will be the new coach to the men's table tennis team, taking over from Alain Chen who will be leaving Singapore Table Tennis Association when his contract expires in December 2010.



The Jiangsu native was head coach of Jiangsu Province Table Tennis ream to 5 years and also had a distinguished career as a player. Yang Chuan Ning has coached and groomed Olympic and World Champions such as Fan Ying, Li Ju, Wu Na, Qin Zhijian, Dan Mingjie, Jing Junhong. In 2006, he was the recipient of the prestigious People's Republic of China Sports Honour Award. Chuan Ning is also the recipient of the Jiangsu Province's Labour & Jiangsu Province Government 1st/2nd Class Merit Award multiple times.

Under his guidance, the Jiangsu Province Table Tennis Team won the championship in the Men's Doubles and the Mixed Doubles at the China National Table Tennis Championships in 2006 and 2008 respectively.
