Paddler Pang Qualifies for YOG

Singapore paddler, Pang Yew En Koen, 16 years old, earned Singapore a berth in the Men's Singles event at the 2018 Youth Olympic Games (YOG) after winning the Road to Buenos Aires 2018 Youth Olympic Games — Oceania qualification tournament, which concluded yesterday.
