The Launch of STTA's 6th Zone Training Centre, STTA-IPS Zone Training Centre @ Innova Primary School.

This is STTA's 6th Zone Training Centre and the <u>FIRST</u> Zone Training Centre located within a primary school premise. During the launch, STTA will also be signing a Memorandum of Understanding with Innova Primary School (IPS) to introduce table tennis to Primary 1 to 3 students during PE lessons.

The introduction of the table tennis programme to lower primary schools is to encourage high participation among young students and to pave the initial pathway to spot promising talents. These talented and promising young paddlers will put on additional hours at Bishan, Tampines, Toa Payoh, Yishun, Clementi and now Innova Zone Training Centre for intensive training. The promising ones will get directed to the Youth Development Squad when they get to Primary 6. This cohort will be further shortlisted to join the National Youth Team and eventually be part of the National Team.

"Innova Primary School is pleased to be in a milestone partnership with Singapore Table Tennis Association to develop the first Zone Training Centre in a primary school. The Zone Training Centre will provide the infrastructure and expertise necessary for sports development and excellence in table tennis, not only for Innova Primary School but also for schools in the North Zone. Table tennis is a popular sport in Singapore and provides a good platform for students to develop character and sportsmanship. This partnership is a strong indication of Innova Primary School's support for the national sports development and it is in line with our focus for quality holistic education, said Mr Michal Saw, Principal of Innova Primary School.

"MOE supports the STTA-IPS Zone Centre initiative as Table Tennis is one of the games taught in PE and this initiative will help to broaden the participation base in sports. Students who excel in this sport will have further opportunities to hone their skills through the Junior Sports Academies (JSAs) and other talent development programmes" said Mr Henry Tan, Assistant Director, Co-Curricular Activities (Sports), Ministry of Education.

"We are delighted to form this new partnership with Innova Primary School. We are committed to introduce table tennis to our children at PCF kindergartens and as an extension, to lower primary schools. STTA strongly believes in early introduction of table tennis to young children and this is where STTA can spot young aspiring talents," said Er Lee Bee Wah Member of Parliament for Ang Mo Kio GRC & President, STTA

Er Lee added, "Following the launch of table tennis program in PCF last year, STTA is working towards having table tennis in the lower primary schools this year. This paved a structured program to nurture our local talents. Our STTA's Zone Training Centres offers a structured and sustainable programme to develop young talents and we are committed to introduce more Zone Training Centres if there is a continuous demand. I strongly believe that with the seeds for the growth of local born paddlers planted, we are able to see results of this programme in the next 10 to 15 years. What's more, we hope that more primary schools will come forward to work with us."
