### REGISTRATION

- 5) Registration forms are available at the STTA Reception Counter from 9:00am to 5:00pm on Monday to Friday.
- 6) Registration form(s), together with cheque payable to "Singapore Table Tennis Association" must be submitted to STTA General Office during the above stated hours.
- 7) Registration will be based on a first come first serve basis. In the event of entries being oversubscribed (more than 16 entries), the STTA reserves the right to reject any entries.
- 8) Registration by telephone or fax will NOT be accepted.
- 9) Late, unclear and incomplete forms will NOT be accepted.
- 10) No refund of registration fees will be entertained.
- 11) The closing date for registration is at **12noon on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2019 (Monday)**.
- 12) Each organization can register a maximum of 2 teams. However, the second team from the same organization will be considered only if there is a vacancy.
- 13) Any event with less than FOUR (4) entries may be scrapped and the registration fees shall be refunded. However, STTA reserve the right to organize the event if there is a short fall of entries.

### ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

#### Team Events

- 14) This tournament is open to players of all nationality. However, each player **MUST** be an employee of the company or member of organization (the registered team) at the point of competition.
- 15) Teams are encouraged to wear team jersey for the event.

### TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

#### Team Events

- 16) A team shall consist of a minimum of 5 players and maximum of 7 players which should have at least 1 male & 1 female player in the team.
- 17) The team match system consisting of the below FOUR matches:  
1 x Men's Singles

1 x Women's Singles

1 x Open Doubles (could be men's doubles, women's doubles or mixed doubles)

1 x Open Singles (could be men's singles or women's singles)

- 18) In the stage of round robin, all four matches shall be played. Should there be a single knock out stage, the match will be stopped when a winning team is known.
- 19) No repetitive player is allowed.
- 20) If there is a tie (2-2) for both teams, the winner team is then determined by the game scores follow by game points.
- 21) Substitution(s) of team line-up is allowed upon **8:30am on Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2019**.
- 22) Team events with 6 or more teams will be divided into groups and shall play on group round robin system. The top two teams will advance to the second stage. If the entries are 5 and below, matches will be played in a Single group round robin system to determine the positions.
- 23) Matches shall be played to the best-of-3-games of 11 points each in the group stage. From Quarter-Finals onwards, matches shall be played to the best-of-5-games of 11 points each.
- 24) No postponement of matches is allowed at any stage of the competition.

## GENERAL

- 25) The tournament shall be run in accordance with the latest rules and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). Rules and regulations can be downloaded from [www.ittf.com](http://www.ittf.com).
- 26) The ITTF approved 3-Star 40+ white balls shall be used during the tournament.
- 27) No **white apparels** (shirt and shorts) are allowed.
- 28) Any other rules that are not covered by the Rules and Regulations will be decided by the Organizing Committee, whose decision will be FINAL.
