- 9) Registration by any other method(s) will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.
- 10) Late, unclear and incomplete forms will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.
- 11) Registration fee paid will not be refundable.
- 12) The closing date for registration is <u>17 May 2021 (Monday) at 12:00noon.</u>
- 13) Any event with less than EIGHT (8) entries will be scrapped and the registration fees will be refunded. However, the Organising Committees reserve the right to organize the event if there is a short fall of entries.
- 14) Any withdrawal from the tournament must email to Mr Leon Lee of STTA at <u>leon lee@stta.org.sg</u> before the registration deadline.

## **ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS**

- 15) <u>Only Singapore Citizens</u> are eligible to participate in this tournament. Participants with outstanding dues to STTA must be cleared by 17 May 2021 (Monday), 12.00 noon. Otherwise, he/she will not be included for the open draw. There will be no refund of the registration fee.
- 16) A player is **ONLY** permitted to participate in the age group category that he/she is eligible for.

- 17) Current full-time national players (salaried by STTA) are not eligible to participate in any events.
- 18) The 9 & Under Category are open to players who are born on or after **1 January 2012**.
- 19) The 12 & Under Category are open to players who are born between **1** January 2009 and 31 December 2011.
- 20) The 15 & Under Category are open to players who are between **1 January 2006 and 31 December2008**.
- 21) The 19 & Under Category are open to players who are born between **1** January 2002 and 31 December 2005.

#### TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

- 22) This tournament shall be included in the STTA National Ranking System. Points shall be accorded based on the following competition classification: T3 19 & Under, T4 15 & Under, T5 12 & Under and T6 9 & Under. Please refer to STTA National Ranking Policy for details.
- 23) The tournament shall be run in accordance with the latest rules and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). Rules and regulations of the ITTF can be downloaded from ITTF website: <u>http://www.ittf.com</u>.
- 24) The list of approved Racket Coverings can be downloaded from ITTF website: <u>https://www.ittf.com/equipment/</u>.
- 25) The ITTF approved 3-star D40+ white balls shall be used during this tournament.
- 26) Events might be played on single knock-out, group round robin or a mixture of systems depending on the number of events and number of entries per event. The organising committee shall decide the format of play after the closing date.
- 27) All events shall be played to the best-of-5 games of 11 points each.
- 28) All players are only allowed entry into the competition hall <u>15 minutes before</u> the scheduled match. Player shall concede a walkover, if the player is not present at the scheduled time. There shall not be any grace period.
- 29) Based on per event basis, a player will <u>not be allowed</u> to continue once he/she concedes a walkover in the knockout stage of the competition. For all the walkover matches, prize money and placing shall be <u>forfeited</u>. Disciplinary action would also be taken by STTA. In addition, ranking points for the event will be taken away and <u>penalty points</u> will be further imposed.
- 30) If a player does not appear at all for one event, <u>no penalty points</u> will be imposed on him/her for that event.
- 31) Seedings for all the events are based on the latest STTA National Ranking points of the respective age category.
- 32) No white apparels (shirt and shorts) are allowed. Players who fail to conform shall be disqualified.
- 33) Opposing players shall wear shirts that are of **sufficiently different colours** to enable them to be easily distinguished from **Quarter-finals onwards**. Where opposing players have a similar shirt and cannot agree which of them will change, the umpire shall make the decision by lot. **All players are reminded to prepare an additional shirt of sufficiently different colours**.
- 34) Umpires shall be provided for all matches in all categories
- 35) No spectators are allowed throughout the competition. Each player is allowed to have an accompanying coach to provide side coaching for his/her match(es). Coaches must be dressed in proper attire with covered shoes (no singlets, slippers/sandals are allowed). A coach is only allowed to do coaching at one table at anyone time. For subsequent competitions, accompanying coaches must also be registered with National Registry of Coaches (NROC).

#### **FIXTURES**

- 36) The <u>complete entry list</u> shall be published on STTA's website: <u>www.stta.org.sg</u> from Monday, 24 May 2021 onwards.. Any <u>discrepancy or omission of entries</u> must be brought to the attention of STTA by Thursday, 27 May 2021, 12:00 noon. Strictly <u>no changes</u> shall be made after the omission check.
- 37) An <u>open draw</u> of tournament fixtures will be conducted on **Thursday 3 Jun 2021 at 7:00pm** via Zoom (details shall be emailed to all participants). All are welcome to witness the draw.
- 38) This tournament is part of the National Ranking Policy. Seeding for this tournament and the next tournaments will be in accordance with the National Ranking Policy.
- 39) Fixtures with match schedule will be displayed on STTA's Website (<u>www.stta.org.sg</u>) from **Monday, 7 Jun 2021** onwards. Kindly take note that it is the responsibility of the player to check for the latest competition fixture and schedule.

#### SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

- 40) All personnel with respiratory symptoms and feeling unwell; on Stay Home Notice or Quarantined Order; or in close contact with known or suspected case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days will be denied entry into the competition venue. They are advised not to turn up. Players who are affected will have their matches scratched.
- 41) All personnel are required to submit health declaration and check in using SafeEntry at the entrance. Body temperature shall also be taken. Anyone with body temperature above 38 °C will be denied entry.
- 42) Masks shall be worn at all times by default. Only players are allowed to remove their masks when competing and are required to put the masks back on immediately after they have completed their matches.
- 43) All personnel are required to maintain safe physical distancing of 1 meter at all times. During competition, players are required to maintain at least 2 meters distancing with their opponents, and at least 3 meters from other players competing in the hall.

- 44) All players are strictly not allowed to interact with players other than their opponent(s) scheduled for the session and must be restricted to competing during the match(es). There shall be no unnecessary body contact (handshakes, high-5s, etc.) and shouting except for communicating instructions.
- 45) Dedicated table tennis balls shall be issued and used for each match.
- 46) Players are not allowed to use their personal towels to wipe the tables.
- 47) No wiping of hand on tables and no blowing on the hand and ball. Failure to comply will result in penalization under the Penalty Point System (warning with penalty points).
- 48) Players and coaches are only allowed to enter/exit the competition venue via the designated entry/exit points. All players and coaches are to exit the competition hall immediately after their match(es) or at the end of the session, whichever is earlier.

#### PRIZE PRESENTATION

- 40) The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held immediately after the finals of the events.
- 41) All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive the prize/s.
- 42) The Organising Committee reserves the right NOT to award the prize money and trophy if the above mentioned regulations are not adhered to. In addition, rating points for the event will be taken away and penalty points will be further imposed. Please refer to National Ranking Policy for more information.
