Table Tennis: Success at 2023 ITTF Regional Hopes Week & Challenge in South East Asia Bangkok, Thailand, 6 to 10 November 2023

In a thrilling display of skill and determination, 11-year-old Zane Ong emerged as the Champion, securing the first position in the Boys' Singles U11 event at the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) Regional Hopes Week & Challenge, Bangkok Thailand, which concluded today. His outstanding display of skill during the tournament highlighted the bright prospects for the future of Singapore table tennis in the region.

Format of Play:

First Stage:

- Twelve talented players from Thailand, Laos, Philippines, Singapore, Malaysia,
 Cambodia engaged in fierce competition.
- The participants were divided into two groups, engaging in a round-robin group system.
- Matches were played in the best-of-five games format (3/5).
- Advancing to the Second Stage were the top three players from each group.

Second Stage:

- Winners from the First Stage (Positions 1, 2, 3 in Group A/B) engaged in a captivating round-robin competition, culminating in a ranking.
- Losers from the First Stage (Positions 4, 5, 6 in Group A/B) faced off in an equally competitive round-robin competition, determining their final rankings.
