Table Tennis: Izaak Quek wins back-to-back silver medals at International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) World Youth Championships in Nova Gorica, Slovenia.

Izaak Quek (郭勇), 17 years old of Singapore and Matsushima Sora, 16 years old of Japan, clinched the silver medal in the Boys' Under-19 doubles category at the ITTF World Youth Championships held in Nova Gorica, Slovenia.

This was Izaak's second silver medal at the championships. He had earlier partnered Annett Kaufmann of Germany to the silver medal in the Mixed Doubles.

In an epic battle against the Chinese pair of Lin Shidong and Wen Ruibo, in which the match could have gone either way, Izaak and Matsushima stunned the Chinese by taking the first set 12-10, before Lin and Wen bounced back to level the match at 11-5.

The Singapore-Japan duo then won the third set 11-8, before the Chinese took control and won the final two sets 12-10, 11-9.

This double silver medal win at the ITTF World Youth Championships adds another milestone for Izaak, underlining his status as one of the rising stars in the world of table tennis.
