Rules and Regulations

TOURNAMENT PERIOD

1) 11 March (Monday) to 17 March 2024 (Sunday)
*competition might start early or later depending on entries received

TOURNAMENT TIME

2) 10:00am to 4.00pm from Monday to Friday 9:00am to 4:00pm on Saturday and Sunday

TOURNAMENT VENUE

3) Smash Park

EVENTS AND PRIZES

4) The events for the Community are as follows:

| 1 | Boys' Singles | 13 years & Under (born in 2011 or after) |
| 2 | Girls' Singles | 13 years & Under (born in 2011 or after) |
| 3 | Men's Singles | 14 years & Above (born in 2010 or before) |
| 4 | Women's Singles | 14 years & Above (born in 2010 or before) |
| 5 | Youth & Masters Doubles | Youth aged 13 years & Under (born in 2011 or after) and Masters aged 40 years and above (born in 1984 or before) |

5) Singapore Smash Trophies and merchandise vouchers/items shall be awarded to the Champions and losing finalists for every event.

REGISTRATION

- 6) Registration is free of charge and will commence on 20 February 2024 (Tuesday).
- 7) Registration links and rules & regulations (R&R) are downloadable from STTA's website:
- 8) Registration shall be made online only via the registration links.
- 9) The closing date for registration is **29 February 2024 (Thursday) at 12:00noon.**

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

- 10) All events are opened to Singapore Citizens, permanent residents and foreigners with valid passes or visas (Student Pass, Long-Term Visit Pass, Dependent's Pass, Work Permit, S Pass or Employment Pass, Short-Term Visit Pass, etc.).
- 11) Current National & IS players are **not** eligible to participate.

TOURNAMENT SYSTEM

- 12) All single and doubles events shall be played with a single knock-out system to the best-of-5 games of 11 points each.
- 13) All players must report to officials' table at least 30 minutes before the scheduled match. Player shall concede a walkover, if the player is not on court at the scheduled time after the match has been announced on court. There shall not be any grace period.

GENERAL

- 14) The tournament shall be run in accordance with the latest rules and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF). Rules and regulations can be downloaded from www.ittf.com.
- 15) No white apparels (shirt and shorts) are allowed.

16) Players are not allowed to use mobile devices to make or take calls at all times during their match(es).

FIXTURES

- 17) The draw for all events shall be conducted by the referee and the organizing committee on **1 March 2024 (Friday)**.
- 18) <u>Fixtures and match schedules</u> will be displayed on STTA Website (<u>www.stta.org.sg</u>) from **4 March 2024 (Monday)** onwards. Kindly take note that it is the responsibility of the player to check for the latest competition fixture and schedule.

PRIZE PRESENTATION

- 19) The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held on 17 March 2024 (Sunday).
- 20) All prize winners **MUST** be present personally at the ceremony in neat attire (no singlet, slippers and sandals) in order to receive their prize/s. Player who concedes walkover will not be entitled to receive any prizes.
- 21) The Organizing Committee reserves the right not to award the prizes and trophy if Regulation 20 is breached.
