## 2.0 PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It gives me great pleasure to present the annual report of 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 as the President of Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA).

The year 2020 has been an unfortunate year for the world due to the COVID-19 pandemic. At STTA, we, too, have encountered extreme challenges that have never happened in the almost 90 years of our existence! But STTA is coping with the COVID-19 pandemic as best as it can. STTA staff worked from home and suspended all its programmes in March 2020.

During the circuit breaker period, our coaches kept in regular contact with the athletes and their parents. The STTA kept everyone on course and in close communication by providing free



online sessions for training, strength & conditioning, competitions and webinars for our athletes.

For instance, the Zone Training Centre coaches organised free online training at least twice a week for their students during the May 2020 School Holidays. Free online competitions such as: "Bouncing the Ball" and "Rope Skipping' were also organised to keep the athletes fit and strong.

In addition, the Junior Development Squad (JDS) players were offered free online training and strength and conditioning sessions on weekdays. For the Youth Training Squad (YTS), Intermediate Squad (IS) and National Team (NT) athletes, they attended free online training and strength and conditioning sessions from Mondays to Saturdays.

Other than the regular trainings, the STTA also organised many free webinars to upgrade our athletes on other aspects of development which are just as beneficial to them.

We also accommodated special requests made by the National Team players. Among these were special arrangements to deliver our table tennis tables to the residence of Yu Mengyu, Clarence Chew and Zhang Wanling for them to continue their own training during the Circuit Breaker.

During this difficult period, we have not forgotten the need to train our employees and upgrade their skills. Our employees attended more than 18 workshops/ webinars during the circuit breaker period. The STTA collaborated with Coach SG to host the inaugural SG-Coach (Full Integration) Level 1 Table Tennis Coaching Course for our coaches and national players. We are very confident that the upskilling courses that our employees have committed themselves to during this time have benefitted them.

The STTA re-opened in Phase Two and brought back its first local tournament – the Crocodile Challenge Cup from 14 to 20 December 2020. The Crocodile Challenge Cup Finals 2020 was graced by Mr Gan Kim Yong, Minister for Health, and it received a record number of entries from the primary schools.

The STTA also organized several table tennis camps during the November/ December 2020 School Holidays & March 2021 School Holidays respectively to re-ignite the passion that was being suppressed for too long!

In Year 2021, STTA celebrates its 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. We have a 90th anniversary logo to mark the celebrations that will take place throughout the year. This new logo, especially designed for the anniversary, reflects the theme "Coming Together". Let us all come together and embrace the new challenges ahead of us, particularly in a post COVID-19 pandemic world!

We kicked off the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations with a goodie bag give away via a car drive-through the car park in front of STTA in January 2021. This event was jointly organised with Mediacorp FM Capital 958 and was broadcast live on air.

We continued our 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations with our outreach to Spectra School in February 2021. Our national players: Beh Kun Ting, Ethan Poh, Pearlyn Koh and Goi Ruixuan had a great time connecting with the special needs students from Spectra School.

In March 2021, the STTA held many activities such as the annual National Table Tennis Grand Finale. The 2020/2021 National Grand Finale received a record-breaking number of entries despite not featuring the team and mixed doubles events. The tournament received over 400 entries for the singles and doubles events.

The STTA also organised the STTA Umpire Course and SG-Coach Level 1 (Full Integration) Table Tennis Coaching Course in March 2021.

In March 2021, our national paddlers also participated in several international tournaments: WTT Star Contender Doha 2021, WTT Contender Doha 2021, World Singles Qualification Tournament and Asian Olympic Qualification Tournament at the WTT Middle East Hub.

At the WTT Contender Doha 2021 tournament, Yu Mengyu stunned the Japanese starlet Miu Hirano in Round 16. Unfortunately, Yu Mengyu ended her run at the WTT Contender Doha when she was beaten 4-1 (11-13, 11-7, 11-9, 11-5, 13-11) by Japan's world No. 3 Mima Ito in the semi-finals. Yu Mengyu finished third in the tournament.

At the Asian Olympic Qualification Tournament, Clarence Chew became the first Singaporeborn paddler to qualify for the deferred Tokyo Olympic men's singles event. In the all-Singapore finals, Clarence Chew defeated his team mate Koen Pang 4-0 (11-7, 11-7, 15-13, 11-4). We are so proud of Clarence's achievement! This is indeed an extraordinary feat! Clarence's achievement is an inspiration to us all. We hope this will spur many of the younger generation of players to dream big and achieve their dreams.

We are excited about the deferred 2020 Tokyo Olympics to be held from 23 July 2021 to 8 August 2021 in Tokyo. Our women's team has qualified for the team event. In addition, Yu Mengyu and Feng Tianwei would be playing in the singles event. Our paddlers are resolutely looking forward to compete in the world's epic event and we invite Singaporeans to give their strong support to Team Singapore to achieve their Olympic dream!

I would like to thank our supporters, sponsors, athletes and their families for their continuous support. I also would like to thank my management committee and staff for their commitment and dedication in these unprecedented times.

My deepest appreciation to our stakeholders and partners: the Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth, Sport Singapore, Singapore National Olympic Council, Singapore Sports School, People's Association, Nee Soon South CCMC, Toa Payoh East CC, Toa Payoh East-Novena CSC, Toa Payoh Central CSC, Bedok Reservior-Punggol CCC and Toa Payoh SAFRA. Special thanks to our media friends too, who have helped to cover STTA's achievements and events.

### 3.0 BACKGROUND OF THE ASSOCIATION

Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA), established is the national in 1965, governing body for table tennis in Singapore. The Association is not-for-profit organization а registered under the Societies Act, Cap. 311. We were registered as a charity (UEN S65SS0005E) on 1 January 2011, granted IPC status since 1 GST February 2011 and registered on 1 March 2009.



The Association is affiliated to Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC) and receives subsidies from Sports Singapore (formerly known as Singapore Sports Council (SSC)). Internationally, STTA is also a member of the International Table Tennis Federation, Commonwealth Table Tennis Federation Limited, Asian Table Tennis Union and South East Asia Table Tennis Association.

The STTA has its Constitution as its governing instrument.

Our mission is to develop world class table tennis players by identifying, nurturing and motivating aspiring table-tennis talents to become the best that they could be. The STTA is also committed to promoting table tennis vigorously by building a significant number of table tennis players to help make a vibrant sporting Singapore.



With the exception of Tianwei, it was more than one year since they last competed in an international competition. Our players were nervous and excited about being able to compete again. With Olympics less than 5 months away, results at these two WTT competitions serve as a good gauge of where we stand among our competitors.



The best performer of the first WTT event was Yu Mengyu. Mengyu had to battle through 3 rounds of qualifications to qualify for the main draw. She dispatched Zeng Jian in straight sets in round of 32. She created the biggest upset of the tournament with a victory over Japan's Hirano Miu in round of 16. In the quarter-final, Mengyu put up an impressive performance against 2015 SEA Games singles gold medallist Suthasini with a convincing 3-0 scoreline. In the semi-finals, Mengyu put up a strong fight again Japan's top player Ito Mima despite losing 1-4. It was Mengyu's best finish since she won Bronze medal at 2018 Asian Games.



## 4.2.4 Asian Olympic Qualification Tournament, Doha, Qatar, 18-20 March 2021

After the World Qualification event, Head Coach Gao Ning had meetings and video analysis with Clarence and Koen to prepare them for the Asian Olympic Qualification event. There was one slot for SEA region. There were only 7 players for the SEA region, and our main opponent was Thailand's top player Padasak. Padasak had lost to Koen in 2019 SEA Games after leading 3-0 in the semi-finals. Padasak also lost to Gao Ning in the singles finals at 2015 SEA Games.

Clarence was grouped in Group 2 with Padasak. If both Koen and Clarence top their respective groups, we have a good chance of an all Singapore final. In his match against Padasak, Clarence was aggressive in his play from the start of the match, and Clarence quickly took a commanding 2-0 lead. Clarence started to be conservative and made few unforced errors and Padasak reduced the Clarence lead to 2-1. The fourth game was close and Clarence edged 11-9. With a 3-1 lead, Clarence was playing with confidence in the fifth game and Clarence finished off the match with score of 11-7.

Despite not being able to train much, Koen still managed to top his group and advanced into the semi-finals. In his semi-final match against Thailand's Padasak, it was a nail-biting first game as the game went to 10-10 deuce. The lead changed several times before Koen won 17-15. After winning the first game, Koen gained confidence and played aggressively according to Coach's tactics. Koen breezed through the next three games in quick time. History was created as it was an all Singapore final.



Both players fought hard, gave it their all in the finals. Clarence was in better shape than Koen as Clarence has been preparing hard for the tournament since February 2020. It was all celebrations for Clarence who emerged as the winner with an impressive performance to qualify for Tokyo Olympics. There were no victory screams or sprints around the table after Clarence won the final point of the match except that he knelt on the floor with clenched fists to his head in shock that his dream had finally become a reality. Clarence wrote himself into the history of Singapore Table Tennis as the first local born male athlete to qualify for Olympic Games!

During the Covid-19 lockdown in 2020, players had opportunities to attend trainings via zoom as everyone had to remain at home. Every night from 7.30pm to 9.30pm, the coaches conducted training for the athletes via zoom. Even though the players were unable to play matches with one another, physical training exercises as well as challenges were given to the players to compete among themselves. Jeremy, STTA's strength and conditioning coach would brief the coaches on the exercises as well as develop videos on how the exercises are being done. With the videos, SWS and YTS coaches conducted the Strength and Conditioning lessons.

Through this lockdown, many players were able to strengthen their physical fitness and at the same time fortify their foundation in the basic skills. Furthermore, coaches were also able to impart knowledge on video analysis and there were increased communication between the players and coaches. During this circuit breaker, the attendance for training almost hit 100 percent which helped in the bonding between the coaches and athletes.

The JDS coaching team led by Coach Jing Junhong was able to go through the circuit breaker with zero withdrawal cases. In fact, parents of the players gave feedback that the players look forward to the zoom trainings every day. Parents were also more assured of the training with the coaches as parents were able to observe the training programme. During the lockdown, the teams focused more on basic hand movements as well as footwork.

Jeremy, STTA strength and conditioning coach also made videos for the JDS players to start them on some basic strength and conditioning programme. Through these trainings, the parents also have a better understanding on the importance of building a physically strong body in order to play better. Coaches also taught our JDS athletes to do video analysis, explaining to the athletes on the areas to look out for. Coaches were also able to identify athletes who have been stressed out due to the lockdown and were able to assist the athletes in the communication to their parents.

During phase 2 of COVID-19, the teams had to be split into many smaller groups due to the restrictions. The coach to athletes ratio is low and the coaches were able to allocate more time on each athlete during training. As the athletes within each bubble are fixed, coaches had to fine-tune their training methods to make it more fun and interesting.

## 5.0 SPORTS DEVELOPMENT

## 5.1 Learn-To-Play (Basic) and Continue-To-Play (Intermediate) Programmes

The Learn to Play (LTP) Programme was developed targeting members of public (aged 5 & above) who wished to acquire basic skills in Table Tennis. At LTP, trainees shall learn the fundamental rules and techniques of playing the game. After completing the LTP Programme, trainees who wish to further develop their skills could go on to the Continue-To-Play (CTP) Programme.



Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, both LTP/CTP programmes had to be suspended from 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020. After receiving the necessary approval, the LTP/CTP programmes were progressively resumed from 18<sup>th</sup> February 2021 onwards at Clementi Sports Hall, Bedok Reservoir Punggol (Hougang) Central Hall and Yishun Training Center. After the resumption, we managed to attract 36 participants to enroll into the LTP/CTP programmes.

# 5.2 <u>Pre-School Programme</u>

STTA introduced table tennis via the Pre-School Programme to PAP Community Foundation (PCF) Kindergarten to K1 & K2 children. The programme had been piloted at Nee Soon South Constituency in 2009. The objective is to introduce table tennis to the aforementioned age group children with the aim of arousing their interest and teaching them the basic skills of the sport. Students who showed potential would be invited to join any of the zone training centres for further development.

PCF Nee Soon South had confirmed 4 classes of STTA PCF Table Tennis Programme starting from Term 2 in 2020. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, PCF Nee Soon South decided to suspend all table tennis programme in consideration of safety of their young students. To-date, they have yet to decide when to resume the programme. Currently, we are only able to deliver the Pre-school programme to Carpe Diem@Hill Top Pte Ltd.

#### 5.3 Zone Training Centres



The main objective of the Zone Training Centres is to promote and develop local talents. The top talents, identified through selection trials, were invited to join the Junior Development Squad as part of the pathway development designed by STTA. Although the programme was forced to be suspended for a few months due to the COVID-19 pandemic, STTA managed to progressively resume the programme after phase 2 reopening with controlled (smaller) class size and strict safe

management measures in place. As at 31 March 2020, the programme has a total of 334 players training in our 8 Zone Training Centres. We were also able to conduct the Selection Trials in November/December 2020 and early January 2021, with modifications made to the format as well as safe management measures in place, to successfully select the players into the Junior Development Squad for further training and development.

#### 5.4 Coaching Accreditation System

STTA organised the first run of the newly developed full integration level 1 table tennis coaching course in April 2020. However, due to Circuit Breaker in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the course was suspended and only allowed to resume in October 2020. A total of 20 participants successfully completed the course in November 2020.

STTA managed to organise the second run of the SG-Coach Level 1 (Full Integration) Table Tennis

Coaching Course from 22 March 2021 (due to complete on 11 April 2021). course This incorporated the E-Learning modules on the newly launched SportSG-ED platform by CoachSG. The theory tests for the Foundation Sports Science Coaching and Theory were also administered online via the SportSG-ED platform. A total of 12 participants attended the course.



To encourage certified coaches to continue to upgrade themselves, STTA organised a Continuing Coach Education (CCE) Workshop on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the workshop was conducted online via Zoom Video Communication platform. A total number of 16 local coaches (non-STTA employed coaches) participated in the workshop on "Fundamentals in Grooming Young Talents". STTA Zone Training Centre Chief Coach, Mr Shi Meisheng, was the speaker for the workshop.

## 5.5 Sports Development

### 5.5.1 Holiday Table Tennis Camp



The Holiday Table Tennis Camp aims to promote and raise the level of the table tennis sports as well as to develop talents from young. Due to COVID-19 pandemic, STTA was unable to organise camps during the June 2020 holidays. With the phase 2 reopening and safe return to sports initiative, STTA managed to organize three Holiday Table Tennis Camps in November & December 2020 with the necessary safe management measures in place. STTA organised another two camps during the oneweek school break in March 2021.

#### 5.5.2 National Grading System

STTA continued to work on developing a National Grading System for Singapore Table Tennis. The main objective of the National Grading System is to provide a platform for amateur players to monitor their progress and keep them interested by challenging and moving up the various grades. The Grading System can also serve as a guide for coaches to develop the fundamentals of table tennis for the athletes. In FY2020, STTA completed drafting the framework of the syllabus and conducted some internal testing with the players within STTA programmes.

## 6.0 LOCAL TOURNAMENTS

## 6.1 Locally Organized Tournaments

In line with the Association's objective to promote table tennis, STTA had planned for the following local tournaments in FY2020, targeting at the various segment groups. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, most of the competitions were cancelled. We only managed to obtain SportSG's approval to organise the Crocodile Challenge Cup in December 2020 and National Grand Finale in March 2021 with some modifications and strict safe management measures in place.

# 6.2 <u>National Ranking System</u>

Since the launch of the STTA National Ranking System on 20 January 2013, we have captured the rankings of more than 1000 players who took part in the series of tournaments organized / coorganized by STTA over the years.

By using the tournament software, we are able to assign ranking points to each of the players for the various competitions and publish them online, which facilitated the participants and parents in tracking the players' ranking.

As part of our efforts to comply with PDPA, STTA also established a Player Identification System where all players are assigned unique Player Identification Number in place of NRIC number to track their competition results and ranking.

The National Ranking System has played an important role in boosting the number of entries for our various competitions. However, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, many of the competitions were cancelled which affected our National Ranking System in 2020.

### 7.0 OFFICIATING

## 7.1 Umpires / Referees

As of 31 March 2021, STTA has a total of 429 national umpires, 93 international umpires and 6 international referees.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, STTA only managed to conduct one intake of National Umpire course in March 2021. There were a total of 13 participants who signed up for the National Umpire course with more than 80% passing rate. The course conductor for the above-mentioned course was Mr. Ronald Wee. An umpire seminar was initially planned in the final quarter of FY2020. However, due to the COVID-19 situation, it was cancelled.

The International Referees are Mr. Ronald Wee Tui Yong, Mr. Joseph Lau Pub Taai, Mr. Koh Tia Poh, Mr. Roger Ho See Bin, Mr. Tan Yin Loo, and Ms. Koh Jun-Li Christabel.



#### 19.1 <u>Summary of Financial Performance</u>


STTA closed the financial year ended 31 March 2021 with a net operating surplus of \$408k. It does not have any outstanding loan as at 31 March 2021.

#### 20.0 FUTURE PLANS AND COMMITMENTS

#### 20.1 High Performance



The key highlight for FY2021 will be preparation for Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games which was postponed to July 2021 due to the pandemic. ITTF has postponed all WTT events till after Olympic Games. This means that there will not be any competitions after WTT contender series in March 2021. As part of preparation, HPE team has invited sparring partners with various playing styles to train with our national team. Shimada City Government had extended the pre-Olympics training camp originally scheduled in July 2020 to July 2021. The team will have the pre-Olympic Games training at Shimada City from 28 June to 19 July.

In FY2021, there are also SEA Games and Asian Youth Games. Youth players are unable to compete in international competitions as most of them are unable to take the vaccine and it is still unsafe to travel. We can only invite sparring partners to train with our athletes. Besides technical training, we will also focus on strength and conditioning, video analysis and injury management.



The HPE team has invited former Intermediate Squad

players as short-term sparring partners to train with potential players in JDS. There will also be sport science workshops for JDS athletes and their parents. There will also be customized training plans which incorporates sport science programme for selected players in JDS.

Wuhan Sports University, one of the four leading universities in China for physical education, had signed a letter of intent with STTA in May 2019 to allow our athletes and coaches to have joint training opportunities with team from Wuhan Sports University. There will also be opportunities for short attachments for our coaches. The MOU which was scheduled to be signed between STTA and Wuhan Sports University at the end of 2019 was postponed due to COVID-19. STTA will plan the signing of the MOU with Wuhan Sports University once the pandemic is over. In preparation for Olympic Games, SEA Games and Asian Youth Games, we have invited 4 players from Wuhan Sports University to have joint training with our athletes.

For FY2021, STTA has planned a list of overseas training and competition as shown in Annex A. STTA is hopeful that overseas training and competitions will resume in the last quarter of FY2021.

### 20.2 Sports Development

#### a) Coaching Development

STTA is committed to support the development of Table Tennis Coaches in Singapore. The technical accreditation policy put in place in end of February 2019 shall continue to provide an avenue for experienced table tennis coaches in obtaining technical certification. With the development of the SG Coach (Full Integration) Table Tennis Level 1 Coaching Course syllabus completed, STTA shall move on to develop the full integration level 2 coaching course syllabus. STTA will also continue to organise Coaching Workshops as well as Continuing Coach Education (CCE) courses for the table tennis coaches to upgrade themselves.

### b) National Grading System

STTA will continue to work on establishing a national grading system to grade players based on their skill level. This grading system will provide an alternative channel over and on top of STTA's local competition and national ranking system, for table tennis enthusiasts to chart their progress in table tennis skills. The system will also provide the basic framework for coaches to develop the skills of their players. STTA is targeting to launch the pilot phase of the National Grading System by end of the year.
