1.0 COMMENCEMENT OF MEETING

- 1.1 Honorary Secretary Mr. Ho Kok Khun, PBM, reported that the total number of STTA Full Members was 28 and the quorum required for the Annual General Meeting (AGM) was 7. There were 17 Full Members present and hence, there was a quorum for the AGM.

With this confirmation by the Honorary Secretary, Chairman called the meeting to order at 7.37pm.

2.0 ADDRESS BY PRESIDENT, STTA

- 2.1 Chairman thanked all present for taking time to attend the AGM. She was grateful to the Management Committee and Sub-Committee Members who served alongside her with their support and belief in the mission of STTA.

2.2 High Performance Achievements

Chairman reckoned that the past year marked a breakthrough for Singapore table tennis, reflecting the steadfast talent development. Notably, Singapore-born players Izaak Quek and Zhou Jingyi made history by qualifying for the Olympics as the youngest male and female paddlers from the country, alongside Women's Team captain Zeng Jian.

Izaak and Koen Pang also ended an 11-year medal drought by winning Silver in Men's Doubles at the ITTF-Asian Championships — a first for a local-born pair. The women's team reclaimed the SEA Championship title after a decade, while youth athletes such as Ming Ying, Lin Qian, and others shone internationally, collecting numerous medals across various WTT Youth events. The year concluded with a stellar performance at the SEA Youth Championships, yielding four Golds, three Silvers, and seven Bronzes — a testament to the long-term investment in nurturing local talent.

2.3 High Participation Achievements

Chairman updated that in FY2024, STTA significantly expanded local participation in table tennis through a vibrant calendar of competitions and development initiatives aimed at players of all ages. Key tournaments such as Dr Ng Eng Hen Cup and Dr Lee Bee Wah Cup attracted more than 700 entries each, while the Crocodile Challenge Cup for Primary Schools saw a record 426 participants from 89 schools. These highlighted the growing youth interest in table tennis.

Over 300 children trained annually at Zone Training Centres, feeding into Junior Development Squads and ultimately the National Team. STTA also ran six Holiday Camps for young players aged 5 to 14, and co-organised the 6th Singapore Junior & Hopes Invitational with Singapore Sports School, drawing 472 entries across four age groups

from nine countries. These efforts underscored STTA's commitment to nurturing talent, expanding access, and sustaining a strong pipeline of future national athletes.

2.4 Looking Ahead

Chairman shared that STTA would be building on recent success as it prepared for the Asian Championships in October 2025 and SEA Games in December 2025, with a key highlight being Singapore's hosting of SEA Youth 2026 Table Tennis Championships from 14 to 19 April 2026. This event would welcome over 200 regional athletes and would showcase our sporting and organisational excellence.

2.5 Donation/Sponsorship

Chairman expressed her gratitude to STTA's Sponsors and Donors, whose support kept the High-Performance Team training and competition at the highest level. Neo Garden's renewed partnership and donations to our athlete development pathway, while new apparel partner STIGA will support us through 2028. Their commitment was vital to helping Team Singapore paddlers succeed internationally.

2.6 Appreciation

Chairman thanked all who had supported STTA's mission. She was especially grateful to the Stakeholders and Partners, including the Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth, Sport Singapore, Singapore National Olympic Council, International Table Tennis Federation, World Table Tennis, Singapore Sports School, People's Association, Nee Soon South CCMC, Toa Payoh Central CSN, Bedok Reservoir-Punggol CCC, and Toa Payoh West- Thomson CSN.

She expressed her sincere appreciation to all Sponsors and Donors, including Dato' Sri Prof. Dr Tahir, Crocodile Foundation, Neo Group, F&N 100Plus, STIGA, Char Yong (Dabu) Association, Mr Matthew Lim and Quantedge Foundation and many others who had helped and supported us in many ways.

She believed that success in table tennis is built on teamwork, and she thanked the Coaches and Players for their hard work, passion and humility.

3.0 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF AGM HELD ON 16 SEPTEMBER 2024

- 3.1 The Minutes of the last AGM were circulated to all STTA Full Members before the meeting. It was proposed for adoption by Mr. Toh Hock Pang, seconded by Mr. Tan Yan Boon, PBM, and unanimously adopted by the Members without any amendment.

4.0 TO RECEIVE AND ADOPT THE STTA ANNUAL REPORTS FOR THE PERIOD 1 APR 2024 TO 31 MAR 2025

- 4.1 Chairman presented a summary of the Annual Reports in her address at the meeting. The reports were sent together with the agenda to all Full Members before the meeting.
- 4.2. The reports were proposed for approval and adoption by Mr. Soon Min Sin, PBM, seconded by Mr Kumaravelu Varadharajan, and unanimously approved and adopted by the Members.

5.0 TO RECEIVE AND ADOPT THE AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD 1 APR 2024 TO 31 MAR 2025

- 5.1 Chairman informed the meeting that the audited financial statements were sent to all full members before the meeting and requested the Hon. Treasurer to present a brief report.

- 5.2 The Hon. Treasurer updated everyone that the STTA accounts for the Financial Year ended 31 March 2025 had been audited by our independent auditors, CA Assurance LLC, who had issued an unqualified opinion.

He reported that STTA continued to perform well financially over the past financial year. While there was no fundraising activity during the year, the Association nonetheless raised \$485k in donations, which was set aside for the One Team Singapore Fund for the Furtherance of Pathway Development and the High-Performance Sports System in support of the development of Team Singapore athletes.

He informed the meeting that the Management Committee had reviewed and accepted the audited accounts on 15 July 2025, before returning the proceedings to the Chairman.

- 5.3 Chairman requested the meeting to approve and adopt the audited financial statements for the financial year from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025.
- 5.4 The audited financial statements were proposed for approval and adoption by Mr. Wong Yuan Jun Eldwin, PBM, seconded by Mr. Bay Swee Huat, PBM, and unanimously approved and adopted by the Members.

6.0 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED STTA CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

- 6.1 Chairman informed the AGM that STTA had conducted another round of constitutional review to align with the latest NSA model constitution. The proposed amendments were circulated to all Full Members on 25 August 2025.
- 6.2 She shared that there was a total of 33 proposed amendment items. To make most efficient use of time, the meeting would go through each item except those that did not involve any change in meaning, such as clarifications, improvements, or grammatical corrections.
- 6.3 The Chairman handed the meeting over to the CEO, Ms. Wong Hui Leng, who presented the proposed Constitutional Amendment items along with the reasons for each proposal, before returning the floor to the Chairman.
- 6.4 The Chairman asked if there were any objections or questions regarding the proposed Constitutional Amendments, and none were raised by the members.
- 6.5 The proposed Constitutional Amendments were subsequently proposed for adoption by Mr. Wong Yuan Jun Eldwin, PBM, seconded by Mr. Tan Yan Boon, PBM, and unanimously approved and adopted by the Members.

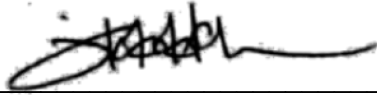
7.0 ANY OTHER MATTERS
